

SALEM TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES
November 14, 2006

Jim Pitsch called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.
Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
Members present: Pitsch, Brower, Mays, Sebright
Members absent: Parmelee

Minutes from October 10, 2006 were approved by consent of the Board as submitted.
Bills for November were approved by consent of the Board as submitted.

Comments or reports taken from the following departments: Sheriff, Zoning, Planning,

Jim Pitsch closed the regular meeting at 7:09 P.M. and opened the public hearing
regarding Oakland Hills Special Assessment Lighting District.
Public comment was taken. A resident next to the subdivision did not want streetlights in
the subdivision and also wondered who was paying the bill.
Since no other comments were brought to the board, Jim Pitsch closed the public hearing
at 7:13 P.M. and reopened the regular meeting.

Old Business

1. Computer use and procedures policy was postponed until the December Board Meeting by consent of the Board.
2. Brenda moved and Don Sebright seconded to accept the bid for Snowplowing Services for Salem Township from William Den Besten. Motion carried.

New Business

1. Don Sebright moved and Brenda Mays seconded to adopt a resolution establishing Oakland Hills Lighting Special Assessment District No. 1. Roll Call vote: Sebright, yes; Brower, yes; Pitsch, yes; Mays, yes. Motion carried.
2. Don Sebright moved and Betty Brower seconded to accept final approval for Rabbit River Farms. Motion carried.
3. Don Sebright moved and Brenda Mays seconded to wait with payment to Forest Grove Equipment for work on the road mower until the meeting with Rhino and Sparta Implement. Motion carried.
4. Because the computers in the Fire Department are not anti-virus protected Don Sebright moved and Brenda Mays seconded to find the most cost-effective anti-virus so all Township computers are protected. Motion carried.
5. In regards to the dangerous building Don Sebright moved and Betty Brower seconded to check the Townships options whether demolition or someone buying it. Motion carried.

Public comment was taken. A representative from the Allegan County Sheriff was present and urged that Community Policing in Salem Township continue.

Advanced Newspaper advertising contract was approved by the consent of the Board.
A work session regarding budget and COPS will be planned in the next coming weeks.
