<u>Solar Energy Ordinance</u> – discussion toward update. Study packets compiled by Jason (PCI) were picked up by members from Township Hall as well as MSU Extension publication "Planning and Zoning for Solar Energy System". Members began by listing concerns to address, including unsightliness, size of parcels, setbacks, loss of farmland/habitat, and parcel coverage limits.

Members covered purpose and definitions with consensus and began discussion of minimum and maximum parcel sizes for private systems. Members were directed to give this thought before next meeting in order to continue discussion and move forward.

<u>Areas of concern to address in Master Plan update</u> – no new areas noted.
