## Recycling Information

Salem Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign-up by contacting the Salem Township Hall at (616) 896-9857.

- Place carts out the night before your scheduled pickup. Only recycling items inside the carts will be picked up. Do not put bags next to carts.

### What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property



## Regional Recycling Depots:

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/Computer, and metal.

Salem Township Transfer Station is open the \*1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month (Closed Jan & Feb)

- Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th St is open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.

- Broken Arrow Recycling, 1100 Lincoln Rd, Allegan, is open Tuesday - Friday 9-4:30pm and Saturday 9-1:00pm. Visit [www.barecycling.com](http://www.barecycling.com) for more information.

## Household Hazardous Waste



HHW can be dropped off by appointment at the Allegheny County Health Department. Contact 269-673-5415 to schedule an appointment.

- Pesticides, herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, & rodenticides
- Oil based paints, stains & varnish
- Paint thinner & solvents
- Motor oil, grease, anti-freeze
- Batteries
- Cleaners
- Aerosols
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Small propane tanks
- Mercury containing items
- Acids & Bases
- CFL & Fluorescent bulbs
