



# Rules and Regulations

*Adopted by the Salem Township Board*

Burnips Flea Market and its managing staff are not liable for any injuries or damage incurred by persons or personal property while on the premises.

## ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES:

We strictly prohibit the possession, use, distribution, trafficking, sale, or offering for sale any mind-altering, function altering, or illegal substances while on the premises. This includes marijuana of any kind including medical.

Michigan law is very clear regarding marijuana use including medical: "Consumption in a public area even in a privately owned vehicle is illegal".

We do not have the ability to determine if the individual is physically impaired, therefore we have no choice but to contact the sheriff department to avoid being held liable for any issues caused by the individual.

## SMOKING:

Smoking outside at the market is not prohibited. If you wish to smoke, please be considerate of our customers and fellow vendors and go to an area away from the market sites.

Smoking inside the hall is strictly prohibited.

## STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED:

- The sale of explosive devices of any kind are not allowed at the market. This would include firearms, ammunition, and fireworks.
- No alcoholic beverages are to be on the premises at any time.
- Sale of food or drinks must comply with Michigan Cottage Laws.
- Signs/Advertising to sell any item not currently on township grounds.
- Sales of animals, birds, fowl, fish, reptiles ext...
- Trailers up to 12 feet are allowed in a single site. Trailers over 12 feet must have a double site. No encroachment on neighboring sites.
- No petitions allowed.
- Trash and unwanted items need to leave with you.

**Violation of these rules and regulations will result in the loss of market site with no refund and you will be asked to leave immediately.**
